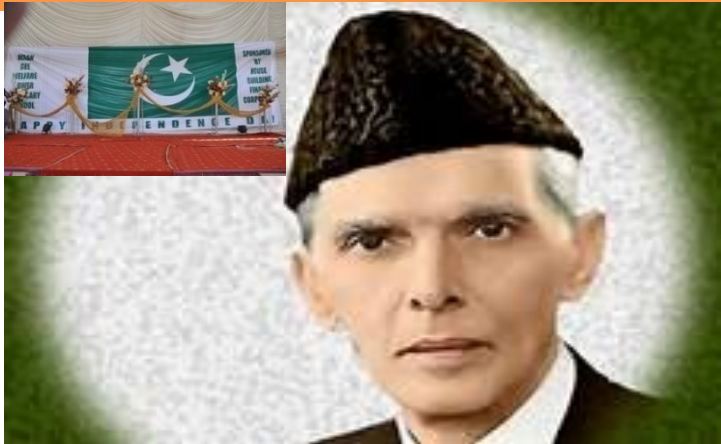

## The Pakistan Independence Day & 21th Annual Award Distribution Ceremony
